PASSENGER NUMBERS CONTINUE TO RISE AT HOLLYWOOD BURBANK AIRPORT


Upward Trend in Airline Passenger Traffic Continues in October 2019

BURBANK, Calif., December 16, 2019 — Airline passenger traffic at Hollywood Burbank Airport continued the upward trend of passenger increases for the month of October 2019. The October 2019 passenger count of 551,544 is an increase of 18.7 percent over the October 2018 passenger count of 464,607. Year-to-date, January through October 2019 total passenger count of 4,903,938 is an increase of 13.5 percent over January through October 2018 total passenger count of 4,319,099.

Commercial aircraft operations increased 21.3 percent, and general aviation operations increased 8.1 percent when compared to October 2018.

Total aircraft operations increased in October 2019 with 13,259 total aircraft operations, a 15.8 percent increase compared to 11,443 total aircraft operations in October 2018.

The top three airlines in October 2019 based on passenger count were Southwest Airlines (370,238), Alaska Airlines (53,564) and United Airlines (38,129).
