



Spirit Airlines Heads North from Burbank, Celebrates First Year of Service with New Nonstop to Seattle

MIRAMAR, Fla., Feb. 11, 2020 – The nation's fastest-growing airline is offering More Go on the west coast this summer by connecting the dots between Hollywood and the Emerald City. Spirit Airlines (NYSE: SAVE) will fly nonstop daily between Hollywood Burbank Airport (BUR) and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) starting June 10, 2020, the airline announced Tuesday.

Spirit started service at Burbank in June 2019 with nonstop service to Las Vegas (LAS), bringing the airline's trademark low fares to millions of people in Southern California who prefer to fly from BUR.

"Spirit is excited to celebrate its one-year anniversary of serving Hollywood Burbank by bringing More Go with new nonstop service to Seattle," said John Kirby, Vice President of Network Planning for Spirit. "Since starting service to Las Vegas, our Burbank guests have responded enthusiastically to our value proposition of low fares, operational reliability and Signature Service."

Spirit's initial entry into the Burbank-Las Vegas market was a win for travelers. In the third quarter of 2019, Spirit's first full quarter of service, the number of passengers traveling between BUR and LAS was up nearly 50 percent with average fares falling by 24 percent. Travelers saved an average of more than \$50 roundtrip.

"We are pleased that Spirit Airlines is adding another city from Burbank," said Frank Miller, executive director of Hollywood Burbank Airport (BUR). "Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) is a leader in moving people and cargo across the country and around the world and we welcome Spirit Airlines and its daily flight to Seattle."

The Hollywood Burbank Airport reached a milestone by serving nearly 6 million passengers in calendar year 2019. The airport offers many people the most convenient departures from the Los Angeles basin and the San Fernando Valley in addition to serving as the gateway to Hollywood.

At Burbank and beyond, Spirit is turning heads by making it possible for Guests to venture further than ever while delivering the best value in the sky. Spirit recently won Low Cost Airline of the Year at the CAPA (Centre for Aviation) World Aviation Summit and unveiled a complete cabin redesign featuring ergonomically-designed seats, an improved aesthetic and a modern look and feel.
