PASSENGER TRAFFIC JUST BELOW PRE-PANDEMIC LEVELS BUT STILL MAINTAINS COURSE

BURBANK, Calif., January 12, 2022 — Passenger numbers in November 2022 finished slightly lower than pre-pandemic levels.

This follows a 1% increase in October 2022 compared to October 2019. Overall, 2019 was a record-breaking year for the airport, with nearly six million passengers served.

Commercial airline operations increased 1%, and general aviation operations were down 30% from November 2019 levels. Total air cargo was down 18%.

The top three airlines in November 2022 based on passenger count were: Southwest Airlines (338,962); Alaska Airlines (44,835); and American Airlines (32,742).
