## December Passenger Numbers Drift Below Pre-Pandemic Levels 2022 Traffic Total Closes in on Record

BURBANK, Calif., February 9, 2023 — Passenger traffic in December 2022 fell short of December 2019 numbers. For the year of 2022, Hollywood Burbank Airport saw a total of 5,898,736 passengers, just below 2019 levels. 2019 was a record-breaking year for the airport, with nearly six million passengers served.

Commercial airline operations decreased 14% from December 2019 levels, and general aviation operations were down 29%. Total air cargo was down 16%.

The top three airlines in December 2022 based on passenger count were: Southwest Airlines (267,850); Alaska Airlines (44,370); and American Airlines (36,434).
