AIRPORT AUTHORITY ACKNOWLEDGES GLOBAL RECOGNITION FOR REDUCING CARBON EMISSIONS

BURBANK, Calif., October 16th, 2023 – At today’s Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority meeting, commissioners congratulated staff for new accreditation that supports Hollywood Burbank Airport’s commitment to lowering its carbon footprint.

Earlier this month, the airport received the accreditation for successfully meeting requirements to enter the “[Airport Carbon Accreditation](#)” (ACA) program directly at Level 2 – Reduction. ACA is owned and governed by Airports Council International (ACI). ACI develops standards, policies and recommended practices for airports, and provides information and training.

“ACA is the only global, airport-specific carbon standard that relies on internationally recognized methodologies for airports,” said Executive Director Frank Miller. “It is an award that clearly identifies the hard work our Environmental Department is doing.”

“Hollywood Burbank Airport is dedicated to reducing emissions through the ACA Level 2 program by setting emission reduction goals, targets and establishing a carbon management plan,” said Maggie Martinez, Director of Noise and Environmental Affairs.
