## Hollywood Burbank Airport Releases March 2025 Passenger Statistics

BURBANK, Calif., April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 — March 2025 passenger numbers finished higher than 2024 levels.

March 2024	March 2025	Percentage difference
505,214 passengers	531,078 passengers	+5.12%

This follows a 1.95% increase in February 2025, compared to February 2024. 2024 was a record-breaking year for the airport, with more than 6.5 million passengers.

Commercial airline operations increased 11.9%, and general aviation operations increased 201% from March 2024 levels. Total air cargo decreased .36%.

The top three airlines in March 2025 based on passenger count were: Southwest Airlines (306,503); Alaska Airlines (74,079); and United Airlines (51,329).
