POWER UP! HOLLYWOOD BURBANK AIRPORT WELCOMES NEW EV SHUTTLES



BURBANK, Calif., May 5, 2025 – The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority (BGPAA) Commissioners celebrated the activation of four new electric shuttles at Hollywood Burbank Airport. The shuttles will carry passengers and employees to and from the airport terminal parking lots.

"Hollywood Burbank Airport is already known for its convenience for passengers," said Airport Authority President Ara Najarian. "These electric shuttles will provide a quieter, smoother ride while contributing to better air quality. This is a great addition, and we are setting a good example for the community."





The EV buses are part of the airport's "Clean Fleet Program", and bring the airport's shuttle fleet to 50% electric. That meets the target set by the Air Quality Improvement Program.

They each seat up to 14 people, with an operating time of approximately 8 hours.

The buses were manufactured by Endera Motors in Ohio, and are built on the Ford E-450 chassis. They were delivered to Hollywood Burbank Airport in late March.

The BGPAA is a joint powers agency formed by the three cities to own and operate Hollywood Burbank Airport. The Authority is governed by a nine-member Commission, with each of the three cities appointing three commissioners. Each commissioner serves a four-year term.



Hollywood Burbank Airport (BUR) is owned and operated by the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority, a joint powers agency created in 1977 between the Cities of Burbank, Glendale and Pasadena.
