Staff seeks the Committee's recommendation to the Commission that it award a construction contract in the amount of \$265,000 to Pacific Industrial Electric for Phase 1 of the Emergency Generator Replacement Project. Staff also seeks approval of an approximate 10% contingency in the amount of \$26,500 to permit Staff to authorize any necessary changes in the scope of the project during the course of construction.

In order to address the Airport's need to have immediate reliable backup power to the Terminal Complex, it is essential that the project move forward as soon as possible. Therefore, subject to the recommendation of the Committee, this item has been placed on the Commission's agenda for consideration at its August 17, 2015, meeting immediately following the Committee's meeting. Staff will return to the Committee and Commission at future meetings with recommendations for award of the necessary construction contracts to proceed with Phase 2 of the project.
