Staff seeks a Committee recommendation to the Airport Authority for approval of the proposed Seventh Amendment to the Lease and Concession Agreement between the Authority and The Paradies Shops, Inc. ("Paradies"), a copy of which is attached (Exhibit A). The Amendment would terminate Paradies' lease with respect to the CNBC lobby store in Terminal B effective February 15, 2014. Paradies would continue to operate all of its other locations per the Agreement with no reduction in the minimum annual guarantee. This specific space will revert

back to the Authority and other revenue-generating options will be explored.

The Authority's independent auditor, Macias Gini & O'Connell LLP ("MGO") has completed its audits of the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority ("Authority") fiscal year 2013 financial statements. Enclosed with this staff report is a copy of the audited Basic Financial Statements for the fiscal years ended June 30, 2013 ("FY 2013") and 2012 ("FY 2012"). Also enclosed are a copy of the audited Single Audit Reports (audit of federal grant programs), Passenger Facility Charge Audit Reports, Customer Facility Charge Audit Reports, Independent Auditor's Report on Compliance with Section 6.05 of the Bond Indenture, Communication Indicating No Material Weaknesses and Auditor's Report to the Authority Regarding the FY 2013 Audits.

In summary, MGO's "unmodified" opinions indicate that:

- The Basic Financial Statements are presented fairly, in all material respects, in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.
- The Authority complied in all material respects with compliance requirements applicable to its major federal programs, the Passenger Facility Charge program and the Customer Facility Charge program.
- MGO identified no reportable deficiencies in internal control over financial reporting or compliance.
- The Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards, Schedule of Passenger Facility Charge Revenues and Expenditures and Schedule of Customer Facility Charge Revenues and Expenditures are fairly stated in relation to the Basic Financial Statements taken as a whole.
- Based on auditing procedures performed, the Authority complied with the terms, covenants, provisions or conditions of Section 6.05 (Rates and Charges) to Article VI of the Bond Indenture, as amended.

Staff will present each report and provide an overview and analysis of financial results for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2013. MGO will present a summary of its audits. Staff seeks a Finance and Administration Committee recommendation to the Authority that it note and file these audit reports.
