- b. COMMISSION MINUTES, APRIL 18, 2016 The draft minutes of this meeting are attached for Commission review and approval.
- c. TREASURER'S REPORT FEBRUARY 2016 Included in the agenda packet is the Treasurer's Report for February 2016. At the April 18, 2016, Finance and Administration Committee meeting, the Committee voted 2–0 (one absent) to recommend that the Commission note and file the report.
- d. AON RISK SERVICES, INSURANCE BROKERAGE SERVICE CONTRACT, ADDENDUM NO. 7 – A staff report is included in the agenda packet. Staff will be issuing a Request for Proposal for insurance brokerage services for all of the Authority's insurance coverages. In the interim, Staff has negotiated an extension of the insurance brokerage service contract with Aon Risk Services ("Aon"), the retail brokering and risk management services arm of Aon Corporation that provides insurance brokerage services for the Authority. At the April 18, 2016, meeting of the Finance and Administration Committee, the Committee voted 2–0 (one absent) to recommend to the Commission that it authorize Staff to extend the insurance brokerage service contract with Aon for one year, with no change in fees from last year's amount of \$90,000.

6. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL

a. AIRPORT BRAND NAME – This item is a carry-over item from the Commission's April 18, 2016, meeting agenda. A staff report is included in the agenda packet. As part of the Commission's continuing effort to develop stronger geographic location identity for Bob Hope Airport, as well as generate additional passengers, the Commission engaged Anyone Collective LLC to provide brand consulting services. Over the past year, Anyone Collective has completed extensive local and national research and due diligence in order to recommend branding/marketing names that will create a clear and strong geographic location identity for the Airport, with particular focus on those prospective passengers east of the Rocky Mountains who are traveling to the Los Angeles area.

Based on this comprehensive research, Anyone Collective has identified four viable potential brand names that will all assist the Commission, potentially to varying degrees, achieve its overall goals of greater geographic location identity and passenger growth. The four identified potential brand names are: "Burbank Los Angeles Airport," "Los Angeles Burbank Airport," "Hollywood Burbank Airport" and "Burbank Hollywood Airport."

The Operations and Development Committee met on March 21 and April 4 to review, receive public input and discuss the options presented by Anyone Collective. As a result of the discussions over the course of these two public meetings, the Committee is recommending to the Commission the brand name "Hollywood Burbank Airport" and defers to the Commission whether it wishes to add the phrase "Bob Hope" to the brand name.

b. AWARD OF CONTRACT, PROJECT NUMBER E15-27, CLYBOURN AVENUE BLAST FENCE PROJECT – A staff report is included in the agenda packet. At the April 18, 2016, meeting of the Operations and Development Committee, the Committee voted 2–0 (one absent) to recommend to the Commission that it authorize the expenditure of \$118,705 to E.C. Construction for the design-build construction of a blast fence along Clybourn Avenue near Hangars 41 and 45, to protect Clybourn Avenue and the residents across the street from jet blast during taxi operations. In addition, Staff further seeks a Contingency of \$16,295 to cover unforeseen expenses as well as other soft costs, including testing and inspection.
