5. CONSENT CALENDAR

- a. JUNE 2015 TREASURER'S REPORT No staff report is attached. Included in the agenda packet is the Treasurer's Report for June 2015. The report was presented to the Finance and Administration Committee at its October 5, 2015, meeting at which time the Committee recommended 2–0 (one absent) that it be noted and filed by the Commission.
- b. AFFORDABLE STORAGE, LLC, CLAIM FOR DAMAGES A staff report is included in the agenda packet. The Authority's General Counsel seeks the Commission's denial of Affordable Storage's claim for damages.
- c. CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF TRIAD INTERNATIONAL MAINTENANCE CORPORATION MONTH-TO-MONTH SPACE LEASE TO HAECO AMERICAS LINE SERVICES, LLC A staff report is included in the agenda packet. At its October 5, 2015, meeting the Finance and Administration Committee voted 2–0 (one absent) to recommend to the Commission that it approve a Consent of Assignment of the Month-to-Month Space Lease of Triad International Maintenance Corporation to Haeco Americas Line Services, LLC. Triad provides aircraft and ground service equipment maintenance (line maintenance) to the airlines at Burbank Bob Hope Airport. As part of a corporate reorganization of its parent company, Triad, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Timco Aviation Services, LLC, will now provide line services under Haeco, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Triad.

6. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL

a. AWARD OF CONTRACT, PROJECT NUMBER E15-08, BUILDING 36 ROOF REPLACEMENT – This item has been included in the Authority's agenda subject to the recommendation of the Operations and Development Committee at its meeting immediately prior to the Commission meeting. A staff report is included in the agenda packet.

Staff seeks Commission approval for the award of a construction contract in the amount of \$118,950 to Best Contracting Services, Inc., for reroofing approximately 10,300 square feet of roofing on Building 36. Staff also seeks approval of an approximate 10% contingency in the amount of \$12,000 to permit Staff to authorize any necessary changes in the scope of the project during the course of construction.

a. JETBLUE BLUE HORIZONS FOR AUTISM – No staff report is attached. Staff will present an overview of "Blue Horizons for Autism," the third annual JetBlue Airways outreach event at Burbank Bob Hope Airport for local families with autistic children to come to the Airport and experience the steps involved in checking in, going through the security checkpoint, and boarding an aircraft.
