As part of the Authority's continuing effort to provide its parking customers and employees the highest level of safe and efficient parking lot transportation, Staff conducted a competitive solicitation for courtesy shuttle services at the Airport. Faced with the complications of an aging shuttle fleet, Staff pursued a turn-key solution that would seek to provide, operate and maintain a new alternative-fueled shuttle fleet dedicated to the Airport. Following a comprehensive competitive selection process, Staff seeks a Committee recommendation to the Commission to award MV Transportation, Inc. an Agreement for Courtesy Shuttle Services with a fixed-price five-year base term (November 1, 2015, through November 30, 2020) with two fixed-priced, one-year extension options available to the Authority.
