HOLLYWOOD BURBANK AIRPORT TAKES NEXT STEP IN JOURNEY TO REPLACEMENT TERMINAL “Industry Day” to provide opportunity for prospective design-build firms

BURBANK, Calif., February 9, 2022 – The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Authority is hosting Hollywood Burbank Airport’s “Industry Day” next week in anticipation of the selection of a design-build firm for the replacement passenger terminal project, now called [ELEVATE BUR](#).

Industry Day will provide a networking opportunity for firms interested in collaborating during the selection process. The event will also provide up-to-date information on the program, allowing for discussion with Airport Staff and consultants who have been collaborating on the program so far.



ELEVATE BUR includes: the replacement of the current 14-gate terminal, construction of the aircraft apron and taxiway connectors; parking structures, ground support equipment and air cargo facilities; airport administrative space; utilities; and roadways.

ELEVATE BUR will bring the airport into compliance with current airport design standards. It is also an opportunity, 90+ years in the making, to create a modern, sustainable, convenient facility that will continue to serve the community for decades to come.
